Dear Church Family,

June, 2019

This year is the 80th Anniversary year of the joining together of two churches in Lewiston, the Pilgrim Congregational Church and the Presbyterian Church, to form the Congregational-Presbyterian Federated Church. The new church located at the Presbyterian Church. Both churches were struggling financially during the Depression years of the 1930s, and each petitioned their respective denominational headquarter for permission to become a Federated church (meaning that while we are one congregation, we continue to belong to two denominations: the Congregationalist and the Presbyterian).

Thirty years ago, a dearly beloved lady in our church – many referred to her as a “saint” – wrote a poem celebrating the 50th Anniversary of our Federated church. Zadie Emerich loved to write poetry, memorializing many events in her life and the lives of others. After her death in 2007, a tribute to Zadie was produced featuring a collection of her poems, prayers and memories. From the tribute: “Her positive philosophy, strength of character and goodwill deeply affected family and friends. She saw adversity as a challenge to overcome and, even with obstacles, had a life rich in blessings, friends and family.” Here is her poem celebrating our church:

The year of our Lord was 1939,
The October weather was fair and fine.
Two churches whose funds were running low,
Decided to merge and build and grow.

One man said, and I use quotes,
“We'll soon not tell the sheep from the goats!”
One church gave their minister a stove and much more
To make the transition an easier chore.

From the Children's Home came those
With no church of their own.
They were welcomed and made
This church their home.

Both churches had many gifts to give,
And were willing to share so this church might live.
The union has continued for fifty years,
In spite of original worries and fears.

These two churches have stood the test,
And these ties that bounds were truly blest.
In the merger came the strength that was needed,
And the pessimists' views were left unheeded.

That two churches could live in harmony,
Has proved to be true in this church family.
Much water has moved beneath the bridge,
In this fifty years of heritage.

A loving spirit surrounds us still,
Helping our cup of joy to fill.
The building and growth that we have known,
Is a bounteous harvest from the seeds that were sown.

So raise your hearts in jubilation,
For our fiftieth anniversary celebration.

I invite you to join me in praising God for his gracious provision for our congregation these many years, and may he bless us for many more years with faithful commitment to him and love for one another.



2 cups crushed cornflakes


1/4 cup melted butter




KELLY'S PICK!

"Tara Westover was seventeen the first time she set foot in a classroom. Born to survivalists in the mountains of Idaho, she prepared for the end of the world by stockpiling home-canned peaches and sleeping with her "head-for-the-hills bag." In the summer she stewed herbs for her mother, a midwife and healer, and in the winter she



salvaged in her father's junkyard. The family was so isolated from mainstream society that there was no one to ensure the children received an education, and no one to intervene when one of Tara's older brothers became violent. As a way out, Tara began to educate herself, learning enough mathematics and grammar to be admitted to Brigham Young University. Her quest for knowledge would transform her, taking her over oceans and across continents, to Harvard and to Cambridge.
