While in Mexico, our students will be building a home for a family in need that has been identified by a local pastor. Working with Amor ministries, our students will wake up each morning, eat breakfast, pack a lunch, and travel to our work site. There they will mix concrete by hand, pour the foundation, frame the walls, and lay the roof that will serve as a home to our chosen family for many years to come. Returning to our camp site, we will take (cold) showers, prepare dinner, worship and reflect on the day's experiences, then go to bed to wake up and do it all over again. I can't wait!

For many of our students, the Mexico Mission will be the highlight of their experience at CongoPres Youth. For a few, it will shape the course of their lives- they will become passionate about serving "the least of these" and dedicate their lives to serving God's people. In fact, Nick Rawson Jr., a former student in our church and youth ministry, now works fulltime for Amor Ministries in San Diego as a result of his Mexico Mission experience. He will be hosting our mission team for two nights at his home church in San Diego. God is good!

Over the next five months, our team of students and volunteers will prepare for our time in Mexico in a number of different ways. We will study Scripture together and pray. Some will apply for their first Passport while others will search their room frantically for their own. We will make food lists and check to make sure our tools are in working order. We will also work to raise the funds necessary to make our time together possible.



FEBRUARY PICK!

CPC Christian Book Club Monday March 2nd 10:30 am in the Chapel

This beautiful, illuminating tale of hope and courage is based on interviews that were conducted with

Holocaust survivor and Auschwitz-Birkenau tattooist Ludwig (Lale) Sokolov - an unforgettable love story in the midst of atrocity.

In April 1942, Lale Sokolov, a Slovakian Jew, is forcibly transported to the concentration camps at Auschwitz-Birkenau. When his captors discover he speaks several languages, he is put to work as a Tätowierer (the German word for "tattooist"), tasked with permanently marking his fellow prisoners.

Imprisoned for more than two and a half years, Lale witnesses horrific atrocities and barbarism - but also incredible acts of bravery and compassion. Risking his own life, he uses his privileged position to exchange jewels and money from murdered Jews for food to keep his fellow prisoners alive.

One day in July 1942, Lale, prisoner 32407, comforts a trembling young woman waiting in line to have the number 34902 tattooed onto her arm. Her name is Gita, and in that first encounter, Lale vows to somehow survive the camp and marry her.

A vivid, harrowing, and ultimately hopeful recreation of Lale Sokolov's experiences as the man who tattooed the arms of thousands of prisoners with what would become one of the most potent symbols of the Holocaust, The Tattooist of Auschwitz is also a testament to the endurance of love and humanity under the darkest possible conditions.



"Then and Now: Church History for Faith Today"


